FEE NOTES

School fees at Leweston include all tuition; lunches and tea for day pupils and all meals for boarders; wrap-around care from 8.00am to 5.45pm, personal accident insurance and many elements of the activities programme. All charges are inclusive of VAT.

ACTIVITIES

Leweston runs an extensive lunch-time and afterschool activities programme which changes termly. The majority is free of charge but some elements incur costs either for materials or to cover external providers. Full details are published termly.

TRIPS AND VISITS

The cost of additional trips and visits will be communicated in advance to parents.

INSURANCE

Optional Personal Effects, Accident Insurance and AXA Healthcare are available through the school. Contact the Bursary for more information.

UNIFORM

School uniform is compulsory in the Prep and Senior School. A complete set of Prep uniform would be approximately £400. Uniform is available online www.lewestonshop.co.uk or in the School Shop.

PAYMENT

Fees are payable on or by the first day of term. Extras will be invoiced on a termly basis in arrears.
Fees can be paid using either of the following methods:

BACS

Account details as per invoice.

CHEQUE

Made payable to Leweston School Trust.

DIRECT DEBIT

Spreads the cost of tuition fees across 9 months with no interest or charges (excluding extras which are invoiced termly).

ADVANCE PAYMENT

Pay for multiple years in advance and save on fee increases for the period covered.

ANNUAL PAYMENT

Pay annually and receive a 2% discount.

SIBLING DISCOUNT (per term against day fees)

Two children attending, the eldest receives **5%** discount.

Three children attending, the eldest receives **10%** and the second child receives **5%** discount.

Four children attending, the eldest receives **15%**, the second **10%** and the third **5%** discount.

FORCES DISCOUNT

Leweston has welcomed Forces families for many years as boarders who receive the Forces' Continuity of Education Allowance (CEA). A means-tested Armed Forces Discount may be available on day fees on application for those not in receipt of CEA.

WRAP AROUND CARE

Free wrap-around care is available for day pupils from 8.00am to 5.45pm. Pre-Prep pupils have a fun after-school club and Prep have supervised homework sessions as well as access to the Activity Programme.

BREAKFAST CLUB

Available from 7.30am to 8.00am. Children are provided with a healthy and nutritious breakfast at a cost of £4.50 per session. Bookings are made through the Parent Portal.

SUPPER CLUB

Day pupils can stay past 6.00pm with notice; supper is available at 6.45pm at a cost of £7.00 per session. Bookings are made through the Parent Portal.

TRANSPORT

HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES
