



## Day Stable Hire and Flexi Stabling Agreement

Day Stable Hire £15, Flexi Stabling £35/night recharged to school accounts at the end of term.

The student is responsible for looking after their own horse (AM + PM stables)

Providing there is space stables may be booked as Day Stables between 07.00 and 19.00 or Flexi Stabling (max. 3 nights)

- All horses will undergo a health check upon arrival before entering the stable yard
- Stables will be bedded up but must be left in the condition found
- Please bring your own hay net and any feeds due labelled in a bucket
- Your horse must be up to date with all their Equine Flu Vaccinations, please show Passport on arrival
- All horses must have minimum of Third-Party Insurance to be on site
- There will be no turn out facility
- Please inform of us of any specific behaviour or personality traits we need to be aware of (ie biting, kicking, head-shy, sensitive, weaves or crib-bites).
- All stables will be disinfected after use
- At least 24 hours' notice must be given to cancel booking
- All tack/saddlery/rugs and rider kit must be clearly labelled and stored where directed

In the interest of safety and welfare of our students, staff and horses by completing this form you are agreeing to provide all the relevant information about your horse and agree to adhere to the rules and guidelines of the stables as published in the Leweston Chedington Riding Academy Handbook.
