



## Exclusive Loan Agreement

### **£385 per week**

Providing a suitable horse can be matched to the rider's ability and needs, a student can have an exclusive horse/pony loan agreement put in place to care for, ride and compete where appropriate. The student will be expected to take care of their horse every day.

### THE RIDING ACADEMY WILL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:

- All livery costs (bedding, feed, supplements)
- Horse Insurance
- Veterinary and Dental Fees
- Tack and all equipment required by the horse
- Farrier
- Horse Physio
- Saddlery checks, repairs or replacements
- Clipping, trimming, mane/tail pulling
- Worming/faecal counts

### FEES AND PAYMENT

- Fees for the term must be paid in advance at a cost £385 per week which includes half term holidays. An invoice will be raised by the Fees Department and shared with parents.
- A terms written notice needs to be given if you no longer wish to continue with the Exclusive Livery agreement.

### ADDITIONAL COSTS

When incurred, the following additional costs will be recharged on a termly basis.

Parents will be notified of any additional costs over the value of £100 prior to the cost being incurred.

- All instruction costs either with a Leweston coach or specific privately arranged coaches.
- Transport to training or competitions.
- Competition entry fees
- Any school organised training sessions, clubs, visits, talks and workshops.
